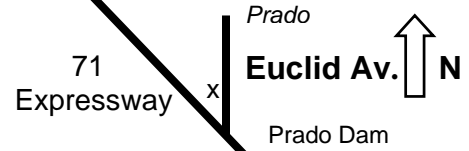

Rules & Policies (in brief)

General Rules are posted at the front entrance to the archery range and on a bulletin board by the practice area.

Members are required to wear club identification in plain view while on the range.

Common sense and safety rules must be followed at all times while on the range.

Gate Combination disclosure to non-members is prohibited. Period. Membership will be revoked.

Close the gate when you come inside during the week. We are open to the public only on Sundays.

- No alcoholic beverages during tournaments.**
- No glass bottles on the range.**
- No shooting broadheads into target bales.**
- No shooting at signs, or poles. Membership will be revoked.**
- No repetitive shooting at roving targets.**
- Use practice area bales only for regular shooting.**

Members also need to sign in on Public Sundays. This is for lease-use and insurance purposes.

No smoking on the range. Smoking is okay by the clubhouse and cook shacks. Please use the trash cans.

Spring Turkey season opens soon, from March 29th to May 4th. There is an additional season from May 5 to May 18 open to junior hunters.

Bag and possession limit is one Bearded Turkey per day and three per season. Don't forget you need an Upland Game Bird stamp for an adult license holder to hunt turkey. Spring hours are from one - half hour before sunrise to 4 pm.

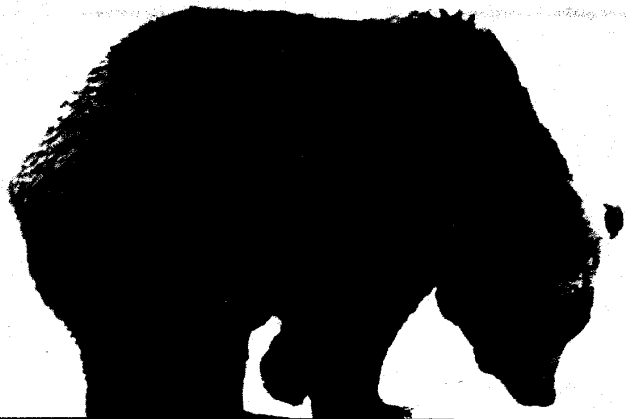

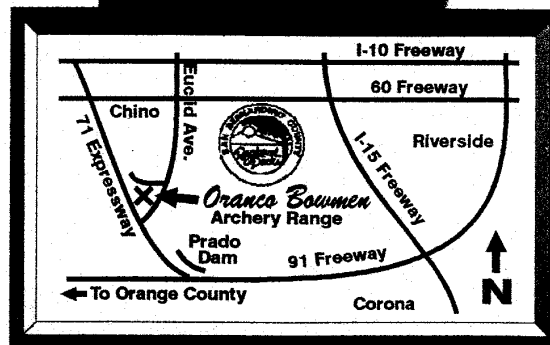
